After this period, the firm will supply the material at its own risk and responsibility. The acceptances of such material with or without re-inspection upto the scheduled delivery period shall be at the sole discretion of Chief Engineer/MM, UHBVN/ DHBVN. Thereafter, Nigam will have a right to refuse or accept such delayed material on the applicable rates, terms & conditions.

#### Clause No. 14 of PO i.e. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT FOR DEFAULT:-

The purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the contract in whole or in part:

- a) If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the stores within the time period(s) specified in the contract, or any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser; or
- b) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the contract within the period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by the purchaser.
- c) If the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract (The definition of corrupt or fraudulent practices defined under clause-25).

In the event the purchaser terminate the contract in whole or in part. Available EMD submitted by the firm/supplier shall be forfeited and available BG shall be got encashed towards recovery of LD Charges and any other dues from the firm.

### Clause No. 28 of Schedule of NIT Blacklisting of the Firms:-

As the purchase order becomes a valid contract between the purchaser and supplier on the date of its issue, no further changes in the terms and conditions thereof are permissible and any request received in this regard from the supplier should be summarily rejected, making it clear to supply the goods strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract. It should be noted that such a liability can be enforced on the supplier only if the purchase order does not contain any term or condition contrary to what had been quoted in the supplier's tender. Once this is ensured, any attempt by the supplier to back out of his commitment should be taken seriously and his earnest money deposited be forfeited forthwith, without prejudice to any further legal remedies open to the Nigam under the relevant laws. Where necessary, the case of supplier illegally backing out of the commitment, should also be put up to the Board of Directors for consideration and to decide for black-listing of the firm and damages, if any, to be recovered

#### 28.1. Procedure for Blacklisting of firm

In case the supplier intends to illegally back out of the commitment, the steps for blacklisting of the firm, besides enforcement of damages recoverable under the law will be taken as per procedure given below:-

- a) A notice shall be served by the purchasing department on the supplier by registered post/speed post bringing his defaults to his notice and asking him to complete all pending supplies / or to settle dispute within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of Notice.
- b) In case the firm fails to comply with the notice(s), a show Cause notice of 21 days shall be issued why the firm/supplier/contractor should not be blacklisted. In the Show Cause Notice complete details of the case, default committed by the firm/supplier/contractor and details of notices issued by the Nigam shall be incorporated.
- c) In case the supplier/firm/contractor fails to comply with the notice issued for blacklisting or does not respond to show cause notice or the reply as submitted is not found justified/convincing. The contract with the firm/supplier shall be terminated inter-alia taking other action as per regulation no. 20 & further the firm may be blacklisted with the approval of BODs.
- D)

The period of blacklisting of the defaulting firm/ supplier/contractor will be approved upto 3 years by BOD's and shall be notified to all Power Utilities in the country and the names of such blacklisted supplier/contractor would also be put on the website of the Nigam.

Keeping in view of above details, competent authority of Nigam decided to terminate the Purchase Order No. DH-2152/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 15.01.2021 & DH-2274/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 18.08.2021 on account of non-supply of ordered quantity of 8334 Nos. 4 in 1 polycarbonate MCBs. Further the process of blacklisting was initiated. Accordingly, as per clause no. 28 of NIT, vide this office memo no. Ch-11/DH-2274/QD-838/XEN/Metering dated 29.04.2022 & Ch-12/DH-2274/QD-838/XEN/Metering dated 25.05.2022, notice of 15 & 21 days were issued to the firm. Further, a final notice of 21 days was also given in accordance with clause No. 23 "Blacklisting of the firm" of schedule-D (Part-I, General conditions of contract). In response, your firm, vide letter reference no. KMPL/UHBVN-QD-838-004/22-23 dated 31.05.22 submitted a reply which was not found acceptable as per terms & conditions of the contract.

The case was considered by WTDs of DHBVN in its meeting held on 08.07.2022 and it was decided to recommend to Board of Directors of DHBVNL to blacklist the firm for a period of three years.

In pursuance to ibid recommendation of WTDs, an agenda was put up before BODs of DHBVN in its meeting held on 28.09.2022. BODs has accorded approval to blacklist of M/s Kanishka Moulders Pvt. Ltd. Noida for a period of 3 year on account of default of nonsupply of polycarbonate Meter Cup Board (MCBs) for single phase energy meter (4-in-1) against Purchase Order No. DH-2274/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 18.08.2021 & DH-2152/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 15.01.2021.

Accordingly, your firm M/s Kanishka Moulders Pvt. Ltd., Plot no.-30. Udyog Kendra-I, Ecotech-III, Greater Noida-201306 is hereby blacklisted for a period of 3 year (from the date of issuance of this communication) on account of default of your firm for nonsupply of polycarbonate Meter Cup Board (MCBs) for single phase energy meter (4-in-1) against Purchase Order No. DH-2274/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 18.08.2021 & DH-2152/RC-417/QD-838/Xen/MM dated 15.01.2021.

This is however prejudice to other terms & conditions of the ibid contract.

Further, your firm vide e-mail dated 14.05.2018 offered 1,00,000 nos. Polycarbonate seals (without any colour wise bifurcation) with date of readiness as 21.05.2018 against PO no. DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.2018. Your firm was requested telephonically and through e-mail dated 28.05.2018 to submit the colour-wise details of 1,00,000 nos, polycarbonate seals offered for inspection. Later on, your firm vide e-mail dated 29.05.2018 revised the offer for inspection of 97964 nos. Seals (Blue Colour) giving the date of readiness as 10.06.2018. Accordingly, Er. Ashok Kumar, SDO/Commercial, DHBVN, Hisar was deputed vide SE/Inspection, DHBVN, Hisar office memo no. Ch-754/IC-04/GO dated 29.05.2018, to carry out the ibid inspection. Further, your firm vide e-mail dated 08.06.2018 re-scheduled the date of inspection from 10.06.2018 to 12/13.06.2018 and then vide e-mail dated 11.06.2018 extended to 17.06.2018. Later on, your firm vide its e-mail dated 15.06.2018, informed that Mr. Shailendra (Proprietor of firm) has met with an accident and his hand got injured in machine in plant and doctor advised him for complete bed rest for 5-6 days and he shall not be able to attend the inspection on 17.06.2018. Accordingly, the deputation of Er. Ashok Kumar, SDO/Commercial was cancelled for ibid inspection (vide this office memo no. Ch-18/DH-1680/RC-233 dated 21.06.2018 and your firm was requested to offer the material again afresh.

Further, your firm vide e-mail dated 22.07.2018 offered 97532 Nos. Polycarbonate seals against PO DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MIVI-II dated 02.02.2018 for inspection with date of readiness as 21.05.2018 (i.e. wrong date of readiness was shown as 2 months prior to date of call) and no place of inspection was mentioned in the ibid inspection call letter. Accordingly, your firm was requested through email dated 23.07.2018 to revise the offer of inspection call with proper date of readiness and place of inspection. Your firm vide e-mail dated 24.07.2018 intimated that the material is ready and requested to arrange the inspection. It was not mentioned about the place of inspection call with proper date of inspection as such your firm was requested again vide e-mail dated 24.07.2018 to revise the offer of inspection call with proper date of readiness and place of inspection as per prescribed format given in NIT/RC/PO. In this regard, in-spite of various telephonic discussions with your firm, no response was received for long time.

Thereafter your firm vide letter ref. no. NIL dated 30.10.2018 requested to accord approval for change in Factory Premises and arrange inspections at Survey No. 173/1, Samarvani, Masat, Silvasa, Dadar & Nagar Heveli-396230.

In this regard, as per certificate of registration (issued by Deptt. of Sale Tax Govt. of Maharashtra) & iSO certificate (issued by QCS Management Pvt. Ltd., Kolkata) submitted by your firm during the submission of tender documents and further during the submission of reply/clarification against deviations, the details of address of works of your firm was mentioned as under:-

Accordingly, being new entrant, the pre-order inspection of your firm was also carried out in respect of ibid works & office premises which was found in order and your firm was considered as techno-commercially qualified in NIT, on the basis of satisfactory pre-order inspection and thus ibid rate contract was awarded to your firm.

The ibid request of your firm for change in Factory Premises and to arrange inspections at new proposed premises was considered by this office and not found acceptable, as the change of works address could not be allowed without any documentary proof)

Therefore your firm was intimated accordingly through this office memo no. Ch-24/DH-1633 dated 17.12.2018 (through Regd. Post) and it was impressed upon your firm to offer the material for inspection and complete all pending supplies from the works that was given during submission of tender documents i.e. situated at Gala no. 108 Rajparbha Udyog Nagar Building no. 3, Golani, Vasai East Distt. Thane-Maharashtra, only.

Through ibid memo of this office. It was also intimated that, in case, the firm fails to supply the quantity of RC/PO the relevant clauses i.e. Clause no. 2 of PO entitled "Delivery period",

Clause no. 7 damages for "Delay in delivery", Clause no. 16 of PO entitled "Supplier's Default Liability", Clause no. 18 of PO entitled "<u>Termination of contract for default</u>", Clause no. 19 of PO entitled "<u>Blacklisting of Firms</u>" etc. shall be invoked and further action shall be initiated accordingly.

However, no response was received from the firm and thus your firm has failed in supplying of material, which tantamount to backing out by the firm from your contractual obligations, under the said RC/PO.

In this regard, the relevant clauses of ibid POs/RC are reproduced as under-

Clause no. 7 of POs/RC entitled "Damage for delay in delivery":-

"The delivery of material as per the Annexure "B" attached to the Terms and Conditions of Contract (Schedule 'D') shall be the essence of the contract between the supplier and the Nigam and the delivery of such consignment must accordingly be insisted upon the date it is due in terms thereof.

No supplies/consignments received after the due date, on which they were actually due according to the terms of the purchase order, shall be accepted by the consignee except, with the approval of the purchasing authority.

In case the purchasing authority decides to accept a delayed supply, the supplier shall be liable to pay penalty @ one half of one percent per week or part thereof of the value of goods so delayed subject to a maximum of 5% of the total value of the delayed supplies. In case the delivery-schedule provides lot wise delivery of material, lot wise penalty shall be imposed."

## Clause no. 16 of POs/RC entitled "SUPPLIER'S DEFAULT LIABILITY": -

"In the event of breach of any these terms and conditions by the supplier, the purchaser can terminate the contract without Notice to the supplier at any stage and the supplier shall have no claim whatsoever on the purchaser on this account. But the supplier shall be liable to pay to the purchaser a sum equivalent to 5% of the value of the undelivered material as liquidated damages and not as a penalty."

### Clause no. 18 of POs/RC entitled "TERMINATION OF CONTRACT FOR DEFAULT":-

- 18.1 The purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the contract in whole or in part-
- a) If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the stores within the time period(s) specified in the contract, or any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser; or
- b) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the contract within the period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by the purchaser.
- c) If the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract (The definition of corrupt or fraudulent practices defined under clause-17)
- 18.2 In the event the purchaser terminate the contract in whole or in part. Available EMD submitted by the firm/supplier shall be forfeited and available BG shall be got encashed towards recovery of LD Charges and any other dues from the firm."

#### Clause no. 19 of POs/RC entitled "Blacklisting of the Firms":-

"As the purchase order becomes a valid contract between the purchaser and supplier on the date of its issue, no further changes in the terms and conditions thereof are permissible and any request received in this regard from the supplier should be summarily rejected, making it clear to supply the goods strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract. It should be noted that such a liability can be enforced on the supplier only if the purchase order does not contain any term or condition contrary to what had been quoted in the supplier's tender. Once this is ensured, any attempt by the supplier to back out of his commitment should be taken seriously and his earnest money deposited be forfeited forthwith, without prejudice to any further legal remedies open to the Nigam under the relevant laws. Where necessary, the case of supplier illegally backing out of the commitment, should also be put up to the Board of Directors for consideration and to decide for black-listing of the firm and damages, if any, to be recovered

#### 19.1 Procedure for Blacklisting of firm:-

In case the supplier intends to illegally back out of the commitment, the steps for blacklisting of the firm, besides enforcement of damages recoverable under the law will be taken as per procedure given below:-

- a) A notice shall be served by the purchasing department on the supplier by registered post/speed post bringing his defaults to his notice antivasking. him to complete all pending supplies / or to settle dispute within a period of 15 days from the date of issue of Notice.
- b) In case the firm fails to comply with the notice(s), a show Cause notice of 21 days shall be Issued why the firm/supplier/contractor should not be blacklisted. In the Show Cause Notice complete details of the case, default committed by the firm/supplier/contractor and details of notices issued by the Nigam shall be incorporated.

- c) In case the supplier/firm/contractor fails to comply with the notice issued for blacklisting or does not respond to show cause notice or the reply as submitted is not found justified/convincing. The contract with the firm/supplier shall be terminated inter-alia taking other action as per regulation no. 20 & further the firm may be blacklisted with the approval of BODs.
- d) The period of blacklisting of the defaulting firm/ supplier/contractor will be approved upto 3 years by BOD's and shall be notified to all Power Utilities in the country and the names of such blacklisted supplier/contractor would also be put on the website of the Nigam."

Subsequently, the matter was deliberated by competent authority on 24.5.2019 and it was decided as under:-

- 1- To issue notices of 15 days and 21 days (show cause notice) under clause no 19.1 (a& b) of PO/RC entitled "<u>Blacklisting of the Firms</u>" giving final opportunity to the firm to complete all the pending supplies or to settle the dispute against Purchase order no. . DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.17 & DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.18.
- 2- Simultaneously, the firm i.e M/s Sushail Industries, Mumbai, may be further directed to submit documentary proof for allowing him to close its old manufacturing unit which was situated at Gala no. 108 Rajparbha Udyog Nagar Building no. 3, Golani, Vasai East Distt. Thane-Maharashtra and for start of manufacturing at its new premises (situated at Survey No. 173/1, Samarvani, Masat, Silvasa, Dadar & Nagar Heveli) along with following documents :
  - a) ISO 9001-2008 Certificate for manufacturing polycarbonate seals at new works
  - b) Certificate of registration of the firm issued by the concerned authority for the ibid works address.
  - c) Documentary Proof for ownership of the new premises of manufacturing unit i.e sale/purchase agreement, lease agreement etc. issued by concerned authority.
  - d) The GST registration certificate for the new premises of manufacturing unit.

Accordingly, a default notice of 15 days was served upon your firm vide this office memo no. Ch-33/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/Metering dated 30.05.2019 giving an opportunity to the firm to complete all the pending supplies against Purchase order no. DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.17 & DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.18. Simultaneously, your firm was also requested to submit the regulsite documents as mentioned at Sr. no. 2 (a,b,c & d) above.

In response of above, vide letter no. Nil dated 18.06.2019 (received on 25.06.2019) some documents were supplied by the firm. However, it is re-iterated that earlier vide your letter dated 26.10.2018 you informed that you have shifted factory premises to Survey no. 173/1, Samarvani, Masat, Silvassa, Dadra & Nagar Havell-396230. Accordingly, through ibid notice of default, your firm was asked to supply the relevant document in respect of aforementioned new premises of firm. However, you submitted below mentioned documents in respect of some other premises as per detail noted below:-

From the above, it is evident that your firm had not only submitted the incomplete documents in respect of different address of works from that mentioned in your letter dated 26.10.2018 but also the documents are post dated e.g. GST Registration Certificate no. 26AIBPP7862N1ZL now submitted is of dated 18.03.2019. Which shows that either your firm has now again shifted works OR the address of works earlier given was fake.

Accordingly, your firm was asked vide this office memo no. Ch-35/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/Metering dated 04.07.2019 to clarify and confirm the address of new premises from where the firm shall manufacture Hi- Tech Tamper Proof Polycarbonate Seal and supply the relevant document of the same, for taking further necessary action by this office. However, no response of your firm has been received thereafter i.e. even after lapse of period about more than 2 months.

In view of above, a notice of 21 days show cause notice of default under clause no. 19.1 of PO was served upon the firm vide MM office memo no. Ch-38/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/Metering dated 15.10.2019 seeking its explanation, "as why the firm should not be blacklisted". Simultaneously, the your firm may be asked to supply the following clarification/ documents:-

- (i) To confirm the address of new premises (through Affidavit duly attested from Notary) from where the firm shall manufacture Hi- Tech Tamper to Polycarbonate Seals to Nigam.
- (ii) The firm may be again clarified that the revised rates fixed with GST by the Nigam are final and there shall be no any further revision in the same.
- (iii) The complete copy of Lease Agreement dated 01.04.2019 showing the address of new premises/works of the firm.

In response of ibid notice of default, your firm vide its letter no. Nil dated 18.11.2019 was supplied following documents:-

- Affidavit of Sh. Shailendrra Patni, Proprietor of firm, (duly attested from Notary) stating that the supplies of the Polycarbonate seals with stainless steel wires shall be done from Sushail Industries, Shop No. 2, Ground Floor, Plot No. 127/2/6, Dan Udyog Sahakari Sangh, Piparla, Dist. Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Pin No. 396 230.
- Copy of Lease Agreement duly attested from Notary, in respect of new works address of the firm situated at Shop no. 2 Admeasuring 100 Sq. Ft. Situated on the Ground Floor of the building constructed on the land bearing Plot no. 127//2/6 Dan Udhyog Sahakari Sangh Ltd. House no. 61 Opp. Piparia Police Outpost at Piparia Village Silvassa -396230

Accordingly, after seeking legal advice on the issue, a team of Er. Amit Kamboj, XEN/ DHBVN & Sh. Arun Kumar, Sr. AO/ DHBVN was deputed to conduct physical Inspection of your firm's vide memo no. Ch-93/MM-905/Inspection cell dated 18.06.2020 to carry out physical inspection of your works i.e. Sushail Industries, Shop No. 2, Ground Floor, Plot No. 127/2/6, Dan Udyog Sahakari Sangh, Piparia, Dist. Dadra & Nagar Haveli, Pin No. 396 230. Subsequently, physical inspection was conducted on 09.04.2021. As per physical inspection report submitted by the inspecting officers, the name and address of your firm has been found different i.e. *PATNI Enterprises, Survey No* 177, Samavarni, *Masat, Silvasa -396230*.

From the above, it has been observed as that your firm had frequently changing addresses which shows the malafide intension of your firm. The details of addresses given by your firm at different times is as noted below :-

From above, it is evident that the firm failed to even show its works/premises during physical inspection conducted by team of two officers.

Accordingly, on the default of firm, a notice of 21 days vide this office memo no. Ch-66/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM dated 31.05.2021 has been issued to firm for:-

- 1- Termination of PO no. DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.17 & PO no. DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.18 with imposition of LD charges @ 5% of the undelivered material.
- 2- Blacklisting of firm for a period of 3 years from date of issue of letter of blacklisting.

And the reply against the above notice issued has not been received till date. Accordingly, competent authority of Nigam decided to terminate of PO no. DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.17 & PO no. DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.18. Further, the process of blacklisting was initiated. Accordingly, as per clause no. 19 of NIT the firm vide memo no. Ch-70/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 29.04.2022 & Ch-71/DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 24.05.2022 notice of 15 & 21 days were issued to your firm. The firm has replied against the ibid show-cause notice vide email dated 24.05.22, however contents/points of firm's reply are re-produced/submitted for further discussion as per details noted below:- "Vide our earlier Mail, we have already informed that the Proprietor of the Firm Mr. Shailendra Patni is down with Typhoid and is hospitalised. All the details pertaining to your Purchase Order is detailed with him. We shall respond to your Show Cause Notice once he resumes the office. Any further action initiated by you in the matter would be at your risk cost and consequences. You are requested to kindly bear with us till then." However, further no reply has been received from your firm.

The case was considered by WTDs of DHBVN in its meeting held on 09.08.2022 and it was decided to recommend to Board of Directors of DHBVNL to blacklist the firm for a period of three years.

In pursuance to ibid recommendation of WTDs, an agenda was put up before BODs of DHBVN in its meeting held on 28.09.2022. BODs has accorded approval to blacklist of M/s Sushail Industries, Dhanukarwadi, Kandiwali (West) Mumbai (now M/s PATNI Enterprises Survey No 177, Samavarni, Masat, Silvasa -396230) for a period of 3 year on account of default of non-supply of Hi Tech Tamper Proof Polycarbonate seals against PO no. DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.2017 & DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.2018.

Accordingly, your firm M/s Sushail industries, Dhanukarwadi, Kandiwali (West) Mumbai (now M/s PATNI Enterprises Survey No 177, Samavarni, Masat, Silvasa -396230) is hereby blacklisted for a period of 3 year (from the date of issuance of this communication) on account of default of your firm for non- supply of Hi Tech Tamper Proof Polycarbonate seals against PO no. DH-1580/RC-232/QD-734/XEN/MM-II dated 16.10.2017 & DH-1633/RC-232/QD-734/ XEN/MM-II dated 02.02.2018.

This is however prejudice to other terms & conditions of the ibid contract.
